

Privacy Policy

The undersigned Maurizia Iachino responsible for data processing of Oxfam Italia, pursuant to Article 13 of Legislative Decree N. 196/2003, stating that: - the personal data are collected in pursuit of the goals identified in the association statute; - The processing of personal data takes place through papers, computer and automated tools; - The provision of data is optional for carrying out the purposes of the association; - A refusal will entail Oxfam Italia to the inability to inform and involve the person in future activities; - the data will not be disclosed and sold to third parties; - the data may be available to Oxfam Italia operators and to the suppliers responsible for sending any information material or for the management of data entry; Oxfam Italia guarantees the security and confidentiality of the data, even when they are processed through electronic or innovative channels.

It is possible to request clarifications and information about the purposes and methods of data treatment or request confirmation of the existence of the data processing, the origin, the purpose and methods of the same data processing. It is possible to request the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or to block violation of the law, as well as to oppose in any data updating, rectification or integration. The owner of the personal data processing is the Oxfam Italia Association, Registered office in Arezzo, via Concini 19, in the person of the legal representative Maurizia Iachino.
