## **SE's Context in Palestine**

There are multiple challenges facing social Enterprises /entrepreneurs in Palestine such as:

• the absence of a legal and tax framework for SEs.

• the difficult access to quality support services specially for /in the Rural areas/people.

- difficult access to financing mechanisms.
- political and security instability







### **Priorities for SE development**

- Raising awareness of the public and of policy decision-makers such as parliamentarians and governmental bodies.
- Building a social entrepreneurial culture by encouraging socially responsible and sustainable businesses.
- Institutional Networking, which is one of the support pillars to Social Enterprises Ecosystem, that can be based to capitalize on experiences, best practices, promote shared approaches.
- Help to define modalities and tools for local MFI by developing something common in between to be as a policy dialogue with the financial institutions.
